	City Judge Jack Allison dismissed the marijuana charge during a suppression hearing in Gaffney Municipal Court last June prior to the scheduled start of the trial, said Police Chief Jimmy Scates.	Find answers Today! ForedosureConsultations

Turnage's lawyer, Columbia attorney **Jack** B. **Swerling**, contended at the hearing that the search warrant used by police in the search was improper.

Allison granted **Swerling's** request for a directed innocent verdict on behalf of Turnage after the prosecution refused to identify the informant whose statement was the basis for the search warrant.

Scates said his department as a matter of practice does not like to name people who supply officers with information about possible crimes. "If we did, we'd never get any information. We'd rather lose the case but not name the informant," he said
